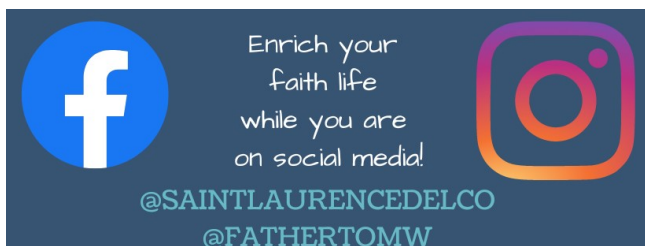

Free Air Conditioners

If you received LIHEAP between November 2023 and April 2024, you may qualify to receive: two free air conditioners; one air conditioner and one fan; repair or replacement of your existing but broken central air conditioning system, or; repair or replacement of your existing but broken heat pump. Contact me for more information. Program closes on 8/31.

Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program

Vouchers are back! If you are at least 60 years (or will be by 12/31/24), have an annual income for one of no more than \$27,861 (no more than \$37,814 for household of two), and are a resident of Delaware County, you can pick up farmers' market vouchers at Friendship Circle Senior Center at 1515 Lansdowne Ave. on Thursdays between 10:00AM and 2:00PM until supplies run out. More information about vouchers at other senior centers may be forthcoming.

In-Home Primary Care Physician Services

Ennoble Care is new to PA, but is not a new company. They provide a physician who will come to the home, as well as palliative care and other services. They accept nearly all Medicare plans.

FROM OUR PASTOR



Catholic Housing and Community Services

My name is Jennifer Rose. I am a social worker employed by Catholic Housing and Community Services (CHCS), which is an agency under Catholic Social Services. 13 parishes in the Archdiocese

of Philadelphia offer this program, and St. Laurence is fortunate to be the newest site to offer the Elder Care Program to those who are at least 60 years of age. We will:

- connect you to resources
- advocate on your behalf
- coordinate services
- help you transition from one setting to another

Components of Senior Care Program include:

- Information and Referral
- Recommending home care agencies; where to receive farmers' market vouchers; explaining the differences between Original Medicare and Medicare Advantage plans and between home care and home health care, etc.

Care Management

- Provide in-home assessment to determine safety, options, and services
- Devise a care plan to address individual concerns
- Coordinate the right network of services
- Applying for benefits such as Waiver or OPTIONS, Property Tax/Rent Rebate, LIHEAP, SNAP, etc.
- Exploring or enrolling in a different Prescription Drug Plan or Medicare Advantage Plan
- Remove caregivers' stress of managing multiple priorities

Through CHCS, I offer care management services to seniors in this area to assist seniors through the aging process by connecting them to services and

supports to prolong independence and improve quality of life. CHCS aims to help seniors remain in their communities and homes as long as safely possible. Services include a combination of home visits, office visits, and phone check-ins.

Examples of work I've done include:

- Applying for rent/property tax rebate, farmers' market vouchers, SNAP, Waiver, Mercy LIFE.
- Helping seniors select a new Medicare Advantage or prescription drug plan during annual open enrollment; or confirm that they are in the plan best suited for them.
- Connecting seniors with home care agencies so that family members can get a break from caregiving responsibilities.
- Making monthly long-term care visits in personal care homes and nursing homes. The seniors feel connected to their parish and allows me to see if they are receiving proper care.
- Bereavement support groups with a Catholic perspective, which evolved into monthly ongoing meetings.
- Following seniors as they transition from hospital to short-term rehab to home. I confirm that they are receiving home health care if needed.
- When the COVID-19 pandemic hit our area, I made calls to hundreds of senior parishioners to check in with them and offer support as needed, such as picking up groceries or medications.
- Nag bureaucracies until clients have their needs met (County Assistance Office, Maximus, Medicare, and physician billing services).

There is no fee for my services.
